Morden Centre (GWMC) is a state-of-the-art, multi-agency facility that is home to Mississauga Fire and Emergency Services Training and Mechanical Divisions, City of Mississauga Information Technology Training, the Toronto Scottish Army Reserve Company and the Peel Regional Police. The facility has been designed to offer a number of diverse training opportunities for City of Mississauga Staff as well as outside agencies and private corporations.

Located adjacent to Mississauga City Hall in the heart of downtown Mississauga, Celebration Square is a \$40 million redevelopment constructed in 2011. Mississauga Celebration Square is an outdoor public square and state-of-the-art multi-media event venue complete with a permanent main stage, amphitheatre and water fountain that transforms into Mississauga's largest outdoor skating rink each winter.

Mississauga Celebration Square hosts a dynamic mix of free events and festivals throughout the year and in 2014 attracted more than 580,000 visitors to 55 events held over 143 days. The summer season offers an eclectic variety of events, including weekly movie nights and fitness classes, concerts, Canada Day and New Year's Eve celebrations, food truck rallies and much more. In addition to a programmed venue, the Square serves as a 'living room' for local residents by providing space for passive recreation and gathering.
